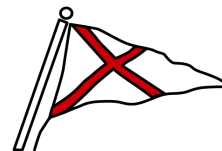
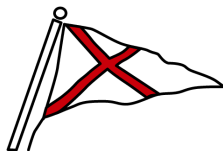

NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2 The applying prescriptions of the Scandinavian Sailing Association and the Danish Sailing Association will be incorporated into the sailing instructions.
- 1.3 Furthermore, the following rules will apply:

Rules for Nordic Championships
- 1.4 The Rules are changed as follows:
- Rules 30.2 and 30.3 will be changed by a prescription of the Scandinavian Sailing Association. The base of the triangle in these rules includes the extensions of the starting line to the starting vessel and to a control vessel in the opposite end.
 - The preamble to Part 4 will be changed, to state that the obligation to wear personal buoyancy when flag Y is displayed not only applies while racing.
 - Rules 35 and A4 will be changed to state, that boats failing to finish within 30 minutes after the first boat sails the course and finishes will be scored Did Not Finish.
 - Rule 60.1(a) will be changed to state, that a competitor can not protest another boat or competitor for breaches for some specific parts of the sailing instructions.
 - Rules 61.3 and 62.2 will be changed to fix the protest time to 90 minutes for competitors, protest committee as well as race committee.
 - Rule 66 will be changed to shorten the time limit for reopening protest hearings.
 - Rule A4 will be changed by stating, that at boat starting later than 4 minutes after her starting signal will be scored Did Not Start.

The changes will appear in full in the sailing instructions.

4.2 Dates of racing: Max number of races:
Saturday 14. August 2010 As many as possible
Sunday 15. August 2010 As many as possible

The plan is to complete a total of 8 races during the regatta, except for CB66, were the total will be 15 races.

4.3 Warning signal for the 1st race each day is: 10.00 hour.

4.4 The attention signals for the following races will be made as soon as practicable.

4.5 On the last day of the regatta no warning signal will be made after 14.00 hour

5 MEASUREMENTS

Each boat shall produce a valid class certificate or measurement certificate at registration.

6 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available at registration.

7 VENUES

7.1 The regatta harbour will be Hellerup Harbour.

7.2 Courses will be sailed on the waters north-east of Hellerup Harbour.

8 THE COURSES

The courses to be sailed will be a windward/leeward course with separate starting line and separate finishing line.

A course diagram will be supplied with the Sailing Instructions.

The planned sailing time for the first boat will be 60 minutes. For the CB66 class 30 minutes.

9 PENALTY SYSTEM

Rules 44.1 and 44.2 are not changed.

10 SCORING

10.1 The Low Point System of Appendix A will apply

10.2 3 races are required to constitute a series.

10.3 (a) When fewer than 4 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

(b) When from 4 to 8 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

(b) When 9 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her 2 worst scores.

11 SAFETY

Danish legislation requires every boat to be equipped with personal buoyancy for the number of persons on board at any time.

12 SUPPORT BOATS

Support boats shall keep at least 50 meters to every racing boat at every time.

13 BERTHING

Boats shall be kept in their assigned places.

14 RADIO COMMUNICATION

A boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

15 PRIZES

Prizes will be given as follows:

CB66:

Nordic Championship Plaquettes for the best 3 boats.

All boats:

Prizes for every 5. competing boats

18 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. (See rule 4, Decision to Race.) The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

19 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of Euro 1.000.000 per event or the equivalent.
